Is this for me?	Remote capture is fast and cheap! However, the footage doesn't look as dynamic as in-person capture. If you have a limited budget, need to capture multiple people scattered throughout the world, need to create multiple videos quickly, or don't care about production bells and whistles, then remote kit option is worth considering.	Shooting at your office can offer savings over filming at a rented studio. This is especially worth considering if you have a unique space worth featuring in your videos. However, shooting on location comes with considerations that could hinder the production quality, such as audio and room size. Fear not! Edios can help find the best angles to make your space look great on camera, or help find an alternative shooting location.	Dream big!
